PDI Movements over Easter, ANZAC and QLD Labour Day Public Holidays

To Brisbane PDI / Transport Operators,

As you all would be aware, AAT Fisherman Islands is currently experiencing significant delays to shipping, which is causing enormous disruption to the motor vehicle industry. In response to these delays and the forecast high volumes, AAT will be amending its operating schedule to include the currently scheduled public holidays on Friday 18 April, Saturday 19 April, Monday 21 April, Friday 25 April and Monday 5 May 2025, as regular operating days.

It is imperative that during these days, motor vehicles are cleared from the terminal to reduce yard congestion and further shipping delays. AAT will ensure administrative staff are available to support all terminals users during this period. Please note, that due to high volumes expected and availability to deliver motor vehicles during this period, AAT will not waive storage charges on these days and our full published storage charges will apply.

AAT requests cooperation from all terminal users to ensure minimal disruption to the supply chain during this time. To assist with yard planning and to allow vessel working arrangements to be finalised, AAT is seeking pre-planned daily vehicle movements for the upcoming public holidays by COB on the Wednesday leading into each long weekend.
